#### Course Description

This workshop offers an in-depth exploration of the figure through black-and-white drawing media, watercolor, and collage. Focusing on design, composition, and interpretation, participants will learn how to elevate their technical skills into compelling, layered artworks. Ideal for those with figure-drawing experience, this course challenges artists to push beyond the basics. You will experiment with complex mark-making techniques and diverse materials, learning how to create drawings that go beyond the surface. By the end of the workshop, you'll complete a finished drawing that undergoes multiple iterations reflecting your deepened understanding of form and material. Whether you're refining your skills or seeking new creative challenges, this workshop offers the perfect environment for growth and discovery.

#### Materials List:

- 1 Sheet 140 lb. (or heavier) of Arches HOT PRESS Watercolor paper, 22 x 30"
- 24 x 24" drywall (Home Depot & Lowes sell these as patch & repair pieces). 24 x 36 masonite drawing board will work if necessary
- Assortment of soft sable brushes: various sizes #2- #8 round, 1/2" flat, 2" flat
- Tape
- Container for rinse water
- Absorbent paper towels or shop rags
- 2B pencil (I prefer 2mm mechanical pencils but not required) & appropriate sharpener
- Kneaded eraser
- Vinyl eraser pen (I prefer Tombow Mono Zero Round)

- Watercolor palette - plastic or ceramic with large wells or even several plastic condiment cups will work. (I prefer Richeson Round Porcelain with 5 wells)
- Scissors and/or X-Acto knife
- Glue stick
- Sketchbook
